Courtesy Boat

The taxi boat service is provided free of charge for berth holders on the swinging moorings. Berth holders in other areas may ask the mooring Bosun for assistance using the launch if they have a lot of kit to embark. This is provided at the Bosun's discretion for a nominal fee.

Recommendations

- All persons using this facility should wear their own life jackets at all times.
- The courtesy boat is run from 1st April till 31st October weather permitting strictly at the discretion of the harbour master. All crews should obtain weather forecasts, or telephone the harbour, prior to leaving home to be sure the courtesy boat facility will be available.

The courtesy boat is available strictly from 9am till 9pm 1st April till 31st October and is not available beyond these times. The courtesy boat runs on the hour every hour from 9am till 9pm every day seven days per week from 1st April till 31st October.

All persons wishing to use the courtesy boat must call on; 07967 404 749 prior to the hour to go to or from their boat.

Requirements

All vessels are to carry their own vessel insurance.

All moorings are for private use, any person wishing to run a business from their vessel must have written permission from the harbour prior to commencement.

No rafting or bigger boat other than allocated is allowed on the buoy allocated to your boat.

No bridles to be above normal length specification.

All normal terms and conditions apply

Payments

£300 deposit is required upon booking and full payment to reach us no later than the 1st April within the mooring year.

Moorings disclaimer by Torpoint Yacht Harbour.

All moorings are certified each year and a certificate is issued by the mooring contractor.

Moorings are only certified to the top swivel supporting the main buoy. Pick-up buoy & warps are to be supplied and fitted by you the owner or a marine contractor prior to using the mooring. It is your responsibility to maintain on a regular basis your pick-up equipment to the top swivel of the main mooring buoy.

Any vessel left on the moorings between 1st October and 31st March are entirely at the owners risk.
